


Discipleship through OVS and Conversational English / ALPHA

Our church plant seeking to follow the Great Commission to "Go and make Disciples" We have continued to use the OVS - Operación Vidas Solidas (Operation Solid Lives) for the members of our congregation, focusing daily disciplines, listening to foundational teachings and developing our personal prayer lives.

In addition, we launched a strategy to both bless our

community and continue discipling those outside of our church. We are using the ALPHA vouth course, a conversational program touching on personal beliefs and faith as a basis to teach **Conversational** English. Speaking English can often mean a 200% pay increase for many young people. classes so far have been full of people and lively conversation!

Disaster Relief Trip to Guatemala

Jared was asked by Foursquare Disaster Relief to respond to the volcanic eruption and ensuing humanitarian crisis in Guatemala in June of 2018. Along with one of our Pastors from El Salvador, Wilfredo Garcia, they visited four Foursquare churches in the affected area, interviewed relief workers and victims and help in the distribution of food to some affected families. Foursquare Disaster Relief (FDR) responds to disasters in the US and around the world, specifically through the local Foursquare churches in the affected region.

Jared will be taking another trip to help host a team in Guatemala in July. This is an ongoing work to relocate evacuated families and help in sustaining those in the outlying areas.
